Accommodation:

November Girl II is a spacious cruiser with twin shaft driven diesel engines. Access to her is gained over either side into the cockpit, this area has an aft bench seat with table for al fresco dining or just to enjoy a drink and watch the world go by. Moving forward remaining on the same level into the main saloon and helm area you enter via double patio style doors, there is bench seating to starboard side which pulls out to make an additional double berth when required. Portside you have the helm position with single swivel seat, behind the seat is the chart table with drawers beneath.

Steps lead down into the dinette/kitchen area, the dinette being portside with ample seating for 4-6 people, this seating also drops down to form an additional double berth. The kitchen is starboard and although compact it is fitted with a Flavel 2 ring burner hob with oven and grill, with fridge and stainless-steel sink with hot and cold water hot water heated by immersion. Staying starboard side, you have the shower/toilet compartment, complete with manual sea toilet, hand basin with hot and cold water and a shower with fitted shower rail and blinds for privacy, and ample storage and surface space.

The master bedroom has a large 'V'-berth with stowage beneath, 2x wardrobes, reading lights and deck hatch.
