Accommodation:

Access is gained via over either side into the large aft cockpit. This provides access to the flybridge and large lazarette.

The flybridge has a winter cover and the stainless steel are fold down.

You then enter the light and airy saloon via the sliding doors. The lighting has been changed to LED

Along the port side is build in teak cabinets with the TV stood on it.

The lower helm station is port side midship. The navigation equipment hasn't been tested and as such is not believed to be functioning.

Opposite is a large seating area and built inside table with internal stowage.

You then step down into the living quarters.

Tbs side is the master cabin. It's fitted with a double bed with built in wardrobe ad TV mounted on the wall.

Opposite is the shower and toilet compartment. This is equipped with a manual sea toilet, hand basin with over basin shower head, work surface, storage and access to the rear of the lower helm station. Moving forward takes you to the galley. It's well-appointed and benefits from a 4-ring cooker with grill and oven. Stainless steel sink/drainer with mixer tap, oak work surface, 3 way fridge, microwave, storage and work surface.

You then move forward to the guest cabin. This has a V berth, wardrobe, storage under the berths, reading lights and a deck hatch.

Inventory:

Navigation lights, VHF radio, GPS, speed log, depth sounder and compass. 240v shore support and battery charger.

Decks:

Anchor, Anchor chain, Electric windlass, Fenders, Warps, Stainless steel pulpit, side and grab rails, fender baskets, radar arch. Bathing platform and davits.

Safety:

Bilge pump, Manual bilge pump, Safety horseshoe, Fire extinguishers, Fire blanket, Horn, and BSS until .
